Moedim (Feast)	Date	Instructions
Pesach (Pass Over) In the first month on the fourteenth of the month in the afternoon is the time of the Pesach-offering to יהוה. Lev 23:5	Nov 12, 2016 evening – Nov 13, 2013 evening	May work the day of Nov. 12 but not in the evening of Nov 12 due to Pesach. May work day of Nov. 13 but not the evening of Nov. 13 due to Feast of Matzot
1st Day of Chag Ha Matzot (Feast of Unleavened Bread) And on the fifteenth day of this month is the Festival of Matzos to יהוה; you shall eat matzos for a seven day period. On the first day there shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall do no laborious work. Lev 23:6-7	Nov 13, 2016 evening- Nov 14, 2016 evening	No work allowed from evening of Nov 13 – evening of Nov. 14, 2016
7th Day of Chag Ha Matzot (Feast of Unleavened Bread) You shall bring a fire-offering to יהוה for a seven-day period; on the seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work. Lev 23:8	Nov 19, 2016 evening- Nov 20, 2016 evening	No work allowed from evening of Nov 19 – evening of Nov. 20, 2016
Chag Ha Shavaot (Feast of Weeks) You shall convoke on this very day—there shall be a holy convocation for ourselves—you shall do no laborious work; it is an eternal decree in your dwelling places for your generations. Lev 23:21	Jan 2, 2017 evening- Jan 3, 2017 evening	No work allowed from evening of Jan 2 –evening of Jan 3, 2017 No work allowed. Cooking is allowed if feast does not fall on Shabbat.
Yom Teruah (Feast of Trumpets) יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying: Speak to Benai Yisrael, saying: In the seventh month, on the first of the month, there shall be a rest day for you, a remembrance with shofar blasts, a holy convocation. You shall not do any laborious work, and you shall offer a fire-offering to יהוה. Lev 23:23-25	April 25, 2017 evening- April 26, 2017 evening	No work allowed from evening of Apr 25 – evening of Apr 26, 2017
Ha Yom Kippurim (Day of Atonement) יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying: But on the tenth day of this seventh month it is the Day of Atonement; there shall be a holy convocation for you, and you shall afflict yourselves,, you shall offer a fire offering to יהוה. You shall not do any work on this very day, for it is the Day of Atonement to provide you atonement before יהוה, your Power. For any soul who will not be afflicted onthis very day will be cut off from its people. And any soul who will do any work on this very day, I will destroy that soul from among its people. You shall not do any work; it is an eternal	May 4, 2017 evening- May 5, 2017 evening	Complete fasting, no food or drink—No work allowed from evening of May 4 – evening of May 5, 2017

decree throughout your generations in all your dwelling places. It is a day of complete rest for you and you shall afflict yourselves; on the ninth of the month in the evening-from evening to evening- shall you rest on your rest day. Lev 23:26-32		
Feast of Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles) On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the Festival of Succot, a seven day period for יהוה . On the first day is a holy convocation, you shall not do any laborious work. Lev 23:33-35	May 9, 2017 evening- May 10, 2017 evening	No Work Allowed evening of May 9 - evening of May 10, 2017
Shemeni Atzeret (8th Day of Sukkot) For a seven-day period you shall offer a fire offering to יהוה ; on the eighth day there shall be a holy convocation for you and you shall offer a fire offering to YHWH, it is an assembly, you shall not do any laborious work. Lev 23:36	May 16, 2017 evening- May 17, 2017 evening	No Work Allowed evening of May 16 - evening of May 17, 2017
