Moedim (Feast)	Date	Instructions
<b>Pesach</b> <b>(Pass Over)</b> In the first month on the fourteenth of the month in the afternoon is the time of the Pesach-offering to יהוה. Lev 23:5	Nov 1, 2017 Wed evening- Nov 2, 2017 Thur evening	May work the day of Nov 1 but not in the evening of Nov 1 due to Pesach. May work day of Nov. 2 but not the evening of Nov. 2 due to Feast of Matzot
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Day of Chag Ha Matzot</b> <b>(Feast of Unleavened Bread)</b> And on the fifteenth day of this month is the Festival of Matzos to יהוה; you shall eat matzos for a seven day period. On the first day there shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall do no laborious work. Lev 23:6-7	Nov 2, 2017 Thurs evening- Nov 3, 2017 Fri evening	May work day of Nov. 2, 2017 but no work allowed from evening of Nov 2, 2017 - evening of Nov. 3, 2017
<b>7<sup>th</sup> Day of Chag Ha Matzot</b> <b>(Feast of Unleavened Bread)</b> You shall bring a fire-offering to יהוה for a seven-day period; on the seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work. Lev 23:8	Nov 8, 2017 Wed evening- Nov 9, 2017 Thurs evening	No work allowed from evening of Nov. 8 - evening of Nov. 9, 2017
<b>Chag Ha Shavaot</b> <b>(Feast of Weeks)</b> You shall convoke on this very day—there shall be a holy convocation for ourselves—you shall do no laborious work; it is an eternal decree in your dwelling places for your generations. Lev 23:21	Dec. 22, 2017 Fri evening- Dec 23, 2017 Sat evening	No work allowed from evening of Dec. 22 -evening of Dec. 23, 2017 No work allowed. Cooking is allowed if feast does not fall on Shabbat.
<b>Yom Teruah</b> <b>(Feast of Trumpets)</b> יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying: Speak to Benai Yisrael, saying: In the seventh month, on the first of the month, there shall be a rest day for you, a remembrance with shofar blasts, a holy convocation. You shall not do any laborious work, and you shall offer a fire-offering to יהוה. Lev 23:23-25	April 15, 2018 Sun evening- April 16, 2018 Mon evening	No work allowed from evening of April 15 - evening of April 16, 2018
<b>Ha Yom Kippurim</b> <b>(Day of Atonement)</b> יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying: But on the tenth day of this seventh month it is the Day of Atonement; there shall be a holy convocation for you, and you shall afflict yourselves,, you shall offer a fire offering to יהוה. You shall not do any work on this very day, for it is the Day of Atonement to provide you atonement before יהוה, your Power. For any soul who will not be afflicted onthis very day will be cut off from its people. And any soul who will do any work on this very day, I will destroy that soul from among its people. You	April 24, 2018 Tue evening- April 25, 2018 Wed evening	Complete fasting, no food or drink—No work allowed from evening of April 24 - evening of April 25, 2018

shall not do any work; it is an eternal decree throughout your generations in all your dwelling places. It is a day of complete rest for you and you shall afflict yourselves; on the ninth of the month in the evening-from evening to evening- shall you rest on your rest day. Lev 23:26-32		
<b>Feast of Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles)</b> On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the Festival of Succot, a seven day period for <b>יהוה</b> . On the first day is a holy convocation, you shall not do any laborious work. Lev 23:33-35	<b>April 29, 2018 Sun evening- April 30, 2018 Mon evening</b>	<b>No Work Allowed evening of April 29 - evening of April 30, 2018</b>
<b>Shemeni Atzeret (8<sup>th</sup> Day of Sukkot)</b> For a seven-day period you shall offer a fire offering to <b>יהוה</b> ; on the eighth day there shall be a holy convocation for you and you shall offer a fire offering to YHWH, it is an assembly, you shall not do any laborious work. Lev 23:36	<b>June 6, 2018 Sun evening- June 7, 2018 Mon evening</b>	<b>No Work Allowed evening of June 6 - evening of June 7, 2018</b>
