All of the feast (moedim) days deal with Nachash in Arum. The feast gives us the skills to recognize nachash and master over it.

### Sh'mot/Exodus 12:14-20

This day shall become a remembrance for you and you shall celebrate it as a festival for YHWH; for your generations, as an eternal decree shall celebrate it. For a seven day period shall you eat matzos, but on the previous day you shall nullify the leaven from your homes; for anyone who eats leavened food—that soul shall be cut off from Yisrael, from the first day to the seventh day. On the first day shall be a holy convocation and on the seventh day shall be a holy convocation for you, no work may be done on them, except for what must be eaten for any person—only that my be done for you. You shall safeguard the matzos, for on this very day I will have taken your legions out of the land of Mitzrayim; you shall observe this day for your generations as an eternal decree. In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month in the evening shall you eat matzos, until the twenty first day of the month in the evening. "For seven days, leaven may not be found in your houses, for anyone who eats leavening—that soul shall be cut off from the assembly of Yisrael, whether a convert or a native of the land. You shall not eat any leavening; in all your dwellings shall you eat matzos."

### Vayikra 23:6-8

And on the fifteenth day of this month is the Festival of Matzos to יהוה; you shall eat matzos for a seven day period. On the first day there shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall do no laborious work. You shall bring a fire offering to יהוה for a seven day period; on the seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work.

All the feast days are connected to the same thought, 7 day Shabbat, eat Matzot for 7 days, count 7 weeks for Shavout, 7<sup>th</sup> month holidays of Yom Teruah, Yom Kippur and Sukkot. All the feast days are tied to Genesis 3:1.

The Feast of Matzot is the first Festival of the Year that happens in the first month.

1<sup>st</sup> Day=Holy Convocation = to deal with Arum

2<sup>nd</sup> Day=Holy Convocation = to deal with Nachash

Doubt on a spiritual level = Arum Arum = Spiritual leavening

Note: 7 days – When a person repeats an action for 7 days, it performs a spiritual zayin (sword) and cuts into the mind so that the thought can be preserved. This is why the Matzot must be eaten for 7 days.

#### ARUM=CUNNING

Nachash is the ego in mankind. Arum is when nachash goes into the negative state. Nachash is the power of desire and when the power of desire goes into a negative state in the mind/head of man, it begins to send to the mind a question of doubt toward the will of \(\tau\_1\). Doubt is spiritual leavening. (Arrogance, pride, doubt, haughtiness, jealousy, envy are all spiritual leavening that causes the soul to puff up and swell up the ego). People who bow down to the ego are not practicing wisdom because wisdom hates pride, haughtiness, etc.

#### Proverbs/Mishlei 8:12-13

I am wisdom; I dwell in cleverness; I provide knowledge of designs. Fear of YHWH is hatred of evil. I hate pride and haughtiness, the way of evil, and a duplicitous mouth.

The will of \( \text{7} \) was **Genesis 2:16-17**:

And YHWH commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, you must not eat thereof; for on the day you eat of it, you shall surely die."

Disobedience of this commandment is what caused the 7 day niddah for a woman which requires her to go through spiritual purification afterwards. Also this is why the man is born with extra foreskin that needs to be cut off. Both of these conditions are to be shedded. Ex: The women sheds her skin through niddah every month with is a cleansing process that she goes through. The man is supposed to have the extra skin shredded on the 8 day of his life which places him in the covenant of \(\frac{7}{17}\). In physical thought, a snake sheds his skin. All sin comes from doubt in the mind.

Kana (to be humble) is the possible mode of the ego and it directs the mind towards 7777

Humbleness directs the mind toward 7777 and moves it in a positive direction

Matzot teaches us to always rely on 7777.
